What is Innovative Transnational Network?

Aim: to build structured **network of Universities, research institutions and business organisations** that will contribute in the **development, future promotion and implementation** of the Joint Master Programme on Social Innovation

Working together on **skills' enhancement and capacity building** on social Innovation and developing Joint Master Programme

Local, regional and national authorities, NGOs, SME, other Universities and research centres, professors and students signed general agreement of cooperation in each partner country, they receive information on the Joint Master Programme



Innovative Transnational Network

Institutional mapping - identification of Universities, research centres and business organisations

Actor analysis: determining nature of interest and expertise of all project's actors

Currently: 175 members of ITN from Albania, Croatia, Italy, Serbia, Greece, Slovenia and few from other countries (Norway, France, India, Netherlands, Romania)

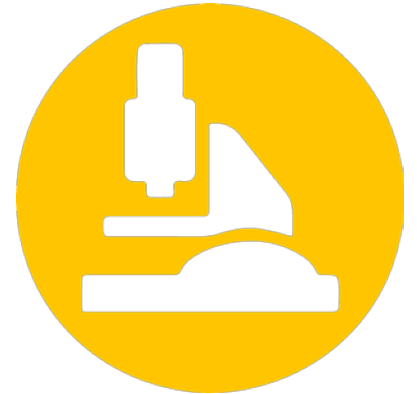
Agreements of cooperation for hosting interns

Business partners: offering students the opportunity to practice social innovation in a real-world context

Students:

- 80 hours of internship in institutions carrying out activities related to the contents of the study programme
- complete a project work on a field related to the work of business partner. The business partner will follow the project as external mentor

Currently: 31 signed agreements in 6 countries (5-6 per country)
